



Annual Club Championship

To encourage participation and excellence the Sailing Committee has agreed that the club championship will be decided by analysing the performance of individual members during the club's annual racing programme.

Results from the following 8 series run over the sailing season will be considered:

- Blue Nose Early Series (year before) (A, SAT)
- Early Bird Series (A, SAT)
- Early Tuesday Series (C, TUE)
- Spring Short Series (A, SUN)
- Early Summer Series (C, SAT)
- Late Tuesday Series (C, TUE)
- Summer Short Course Series (A, SUN)
- Late Summer Series (C, SAT)

A = All-in start C = Class starts

For inclusion in the championship analysis a member must enter a minimum of 4 series from the above list (members may sail any combination of boats) of which:

- 1 series must have class starts
- 2 series must have all-in starts

The member's results will be analysed as follows:

- A member's placing in each series of 1st to 5th will score 1 for 1st, 2 for 2nd, etc. (In class start series placings within each class will count)
- Any member competing in a series but placed 6th or higher will score 6
- Lowest five recorded scores count (Any member who only entered 4 series will score 8 in the 5th series)
- Scores for these 5 series will be totalled and averaged.
- Lowest score wins

In the event of a tie the following criteria (in sequence) will be considered:

1. Number of series entered out of the five series
2. Number of series first places achieved within the five series
3. Number of series second places achieved within the five series

The winner will be awarded the LOSSC Club Championship and the runner-up will be awarded the Parry's Pot.
